On 9-18-75, Alan Parker, Chief Counsel for the House Subcommittee on Civil and Constitutional Rights, advised Mr. Hotis that Chairman Don Edwards discussed this matter with Chairman Rodino who asked that the hearings be delayed until he returns from Europe on September 29, 1975. Accordingly, the hearings have now been scheduled for 10 a.m. on Thursday, October 2, 1975. It is expected that Mr. Edwards will contact the Attorney General today and propose that Mr. Levi and Mr. Kelley meet with Chairman Edwards on the 29th or 30th of September to discuss the scope of the hearings and decide what matters may be appropriately considered in public session.
