HOUSTUDY

By memorandum dated 9/4/75, it was recommended and approved that we brief the House Select Committee and the Senate Select Committee concerning the threatening note received by the Dallas FBI Office from Lee Harvey Oswald.

Subsequent to the aforementioned memorandum, we received a request for material and access to Bureau employees for interview purposes from the House Select Committee concerning the same topic. Our response to this particular request was forwarded to the Department for approval and to be sent to the Committee recommending that a briefing be held instead of complying with the request for documents and interviews of Bureau employees. In view of the written response awaiting approval by the Department for a briefing, no arrangements were made to brief the House Select or Senate Select Committees pending the decision of the Deputy Attorney General's Office.

Subsequently, the Deputy Attorney General's Office did not approve our letter offering a briefing to the House Select Committee. In view of this decision and the fact that we have given public testimony concerning this matter, it would appear a briefing would no longer be useful for the Senate Select or House Select Committees. In this regard, we have not received a request for material or information concerning the threatening note received by the Dallas FBI Office from Lee Harvey Oswald from the Senate Select Committee.
