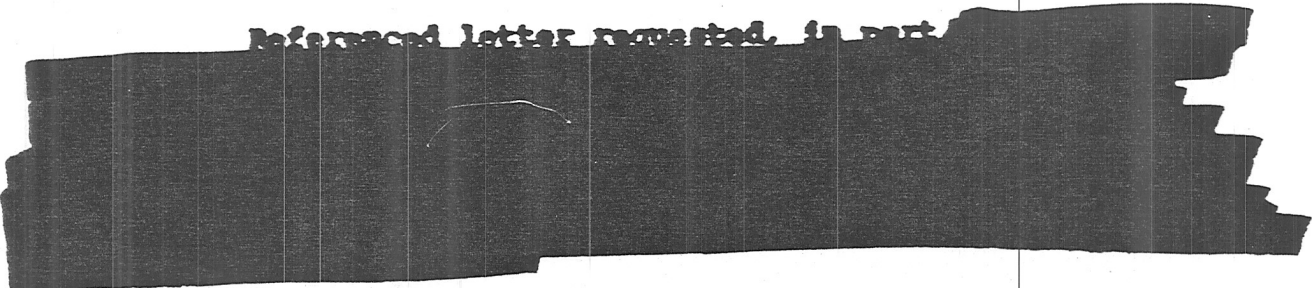

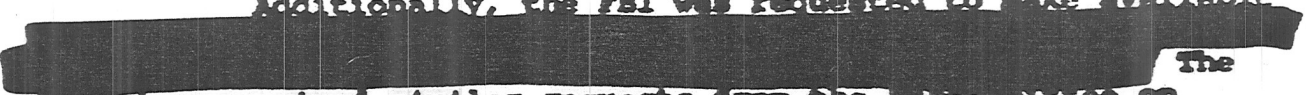

The FBI has received similar requests from the Subcommittee on Civil and Constitutional Rights of the House Committee on the Judiciary and the United States House Select Committee on Intelligence Activities. The Bureau has testified before the Subcommittee on Civil and Constitutional Rights of the House Committee on the Judiciary concerning this matter and hearings before that Committee are anticipated on that topic in the immediate future.
