THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE HAS REQUESTED THAT SPECIAL AGENT JONES P. HESTY BE MADE AVAILABLE IN WASHINGTON, D.C., FOR A TESTIMONY BEFORE COMMITTEE ON 12/4/73 CONCERNING HIS PARTICIPATION OR THE BUREAU'S INVESTIGATION INTO THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY. SPECIAL AGENT HESTY SHOULD ARRANGE TO ARRIVE IN WASHINGTON, D.C., IN TIME TO BE ADVISED BY TELETYPE ARRIVAL OF THE BUREAU DOCUMENT AND EVIDENCE DESTROYING AT 10 A.M. ON 12/3/73 IN ROOM 3628 OF J. EDGAR HOOVER BUILDING.

NOTE: Paul Wallach, Senate Select Committee Staff Member, requested that SA Hesty be made available.
