THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE HAS REQUESTED THAT SPECIAL AGENT JAMES P. HOSTY BE MADE AVAILABLE IN WASHINGTON, D.C., FOR A BRIEF BY THE COMMITTEE ON 12/1/75 CONCERNING HIS KNOWLEDGE OF THE BUREAU'S INVESTIGATION INTO THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY. SPECIAL AGENT HOSTY SHOULD ARRANGE TO ARRIVE IN WASHINGTON, D.C., IN TIME TO BE MET BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGAL COUNSEL AND INTELLIGENCE DIVISIONS AT 10 A.M. ON 12/1/75 IN ROOM 3612 OF J. EDGAR HOOVER BUILDING.

NOTE: Paul Wallach, Senate Select Committee Staff Member, requested that SA Hosty be made available. He specified the following areas as being areas in which Hosty will be asked questions: (1) his knowledge of the Bureau's pre-assassination investigation of Lee Harvey Oswald and Marina Oswald; (2) his observations at the interview of Lee Harvey Oswald; and (3) his activities after the assassination and prior to his transfer to Kansas City. This communication will serve as approval for the waiver of any existing employment agreement signed by SA Hosty.
