On 11-25-63 [REDACTED] furnished the following information:  
As a result of seeing a photograph of LEE OSWALD in the News-  
paper and on television he recalls an individual coming to  
[REDACTED] the last week  
in July or the first week in August [REDACTED]  
contact with [REDACTED] and was prior to the  
[REDACTED] by OSWALD.

The individual believed to be OSWALD came to the [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] asked questions for a very short time concerning [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] He noted [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] OSWALD  
asked if there were many Cubans in New Orleans and said that he  
was interested in Cubans in New Orleans. Nothing further is  
recalled regarding the conversation and this is the only possible  
CONTACT with [REDACTED] OSWALD. OSWALD was alone at the time.

[REDACTED] does not know of any Fair Play for Cuba  
Committee in New Orleans but recalled that in the Fall of 1962  
an individual named [REDACTED] spoke at [REDACTED] After he spoke  
an individual named [REDACTED] came to the stand and argued in  
belaf of Cuba. He was not there but said that [REDACTED]  
had the details regarding this.
