Dear Mr. Bair,

Last November 28 I wrote you, among other things asking again for accountings I never received.

When I received no reply I wrote again February 4 of this year. In that letter I remember that you have never explained my earlier inquiries about Dell's purchase of copies of the original printing of my first book.

You did send me a release that would end all Dell obligation to me when Eunice K. Boehle responded under date of February 8. Because she said you had never received my November letter, which the post office also did not return to me, under date of February 11 I sent her a copy of it.

To date there has been no response.

I believe I have asked no more than I am entitled to.

This record makes me believe that Dell has special reasons for refusing to supply the answers to these perfectly proper questions. That they exist at all is Dell's fault, including you, personally, because I raised these questions with you personally, including justification for your bookkeeping entry of the purchase of my printings as a "joint venture." There is no such agreement between us in any form.

I tell you quite frankly that I have what I regard as absolute proof that the accountings are not full and honest.

In telling you this I also remind you that some were under oath.

If you continue to stall, I will have to seek other means of resolving these matters. I would prefer not to.

I believe both our interests are best served by proceeding honestly and straightforwardly to clean this up.



STICK POSTAGE STAMPS TO ARTICLE TO COVER POSTAGE (first class or airmail),
 CERTIFIED MAIL FEE, AND CHARGES FOR ANY SELECTED OPTIONAL SERVICES. (see front)

1. If you want this receipt postmarked, stick the gummed stub on the left portion of the address side of the article, leaving the receipt attached, and present the article at a post office service window or hand it to your rural carrier. (no extra charge)
2. If you do not want this receipt postmarked, stick the gummed stub on the left portion of the address side of the article, date, detach and retain the receipt, and mail the article.
3. If you want a return receipt, write the certified-mail number and your name and address on a return receipt card, Form 3811, and attach it to the back of the article by means of the gummed ends. Endorse front of article RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED.
4. If you want the article delivered only to the addressee, endorse it on the front DELIVER TO ADDRESSEE ONLY. Place the same endorsement in line 2 of the return receipt card if that service is requested.
5. Save this receipt and present it if you make inquiry.
