Dear Mr. Bair,

You have not replied to my letter of 11/28/73. I would appreciate answers to the questions I asked or an explanation of why I am not entitled to them.

Such things as reversion of rights and accountings I would imagine are normal. I believe they are provided for in the contracts.

Your silence has caused me to think. I am reminded that you have also not responded to my inquiries about Dell's purchase of copies of my original edition to use in promoting its reprint.

You once sent me pages of your records indicating you carried this as what you called a "joint venture." There was no such agreement and I have a copy of a contract that specifies an entirely different arrangement.

I believe this is a matter you would prefer to address. I certainly would like you to.

May I please hear from you on all these things?
