Dear Harold:

I am enclosing a check for \$637.52. The explanation of how this sum was arrived at is found in the enclosed royalty statement and I hope I clarified any other confusion that may exist. Also enclosed is a copy of the original check, the original envelope (to show that it was mailed over a week after the check was signed) and the attached statement.

I couldn't reach Baer today but I did have nearly all of my files copied at Pavsner's. I spoke with him briefly and he said he was now reading through the correspondence and would discuss it with Galèm and write to you what he advises.

All the royalty statements: 6/30/67; 12/31/67/ 6/30/68; 12/30/68.

There is more of course but I thought it best for Pavsner to have these immediately. For the rest, I have to do some digging.

Pavsner asked for all the books involved, especially Meredith's. He also wants to get all the information that John Starr has.

If there is anything that you think he must have (I assume you sent both the original agreement with Dell, your second agreement, and the tentative distribution agreement) please let me know. I still have not called SCLC but will try early next week.

Give my regards to Lil. Has she stopped working? I am anxious to visit.
