### Mother of Oswald Backs Garrison

CINCINNATI, Ohio (AP) — Mrs. Marguerite Oswald, mother of the alleged assassin of President Kennedy, said Wednesday night the arrest of Clay Shaw in New Orleans was "the best news I've heard so far."

Mrs. Oswald, who visited Cincinnati to appear on a women's program, sent a telegram congratulating Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison and saying "hard work and effort will solve the case."

Mrs. Oswald said her son never mentioned any of his New Orleans acquaintances by name.

During the show earlier in the day, Mrs. Oswald said she had offered to help Garrison with his probe, but received no reply.
