Life Dicker**

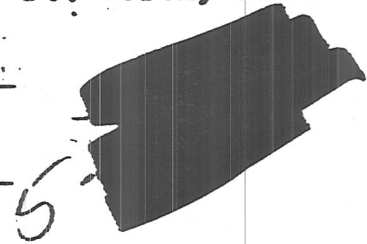
