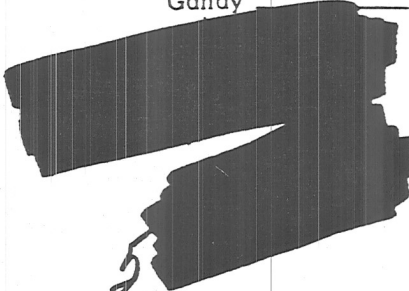
### Oswald's Mother Watched During Humphrey Visit

FORT WORTH (UPI) — Police have confirmed that Mrs. Marguerite Oswald, mother of presidential assassin Lee Harvey Oswald, was placed under surveillance while Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey was in Dallas last night.

Humphrey spoke to Democratic leaders from four Southwestern states about the 1968 campaigns.

Police said the Secret Service had requested the surveillance between 4:30 p.m. and 10 p.m. while the vice president was in town. Officers said the same procedure had been followed when Humphrey visited Texas in the past.

Mrs. Oswald said she had protested in letters to President Johnson on previous occasions.
