MARGUERITE OSWALD - VICTIM - Mr EXTORTION As a matter of information this is to advise that on 11-17-64, Mrs. Marguerite Oswald (mother of Lee Harvey Oswald) advised Agents of our Dallas office that she had received a threatening letter at her residence at Ft. Worth, Texas, which had been postmarked "Manchester, Conn., Nov. 14, 1964-PM." This letter read as follows: "Marguerite Oswald "On Nov. 22, I will put a Bullet in your head. Just like Your dirty Bastard of a Son did to Our President Your Dirty Bastard of a Son Now lies in Hell You will soon be with him" Mrs. Oswald stated that she had no suspect in this matter and made the letter available for examination by our Laporatory. She requested that the letter be returned to her at completion of our examination, and at her request she was given a receipt for the letter. Appropriate officials of the Ft. Worth Police Department and Tarrant County Sheriff's Office were advised of the contents of the threatening letter received by Mrs. Oswald. On 11-18-64, Assistant United States Attorney Canard Florence at Ft. Worth, advised that the letter received by Mrs. Oswald has all the essential elements to constitute a violation of the Extortion Statute. REC- 109 ACTION: The Bureau's Laboratory is examining the threatening letter in an attempt to identify the writer of same, and our New Haven office is conducting investigation in an attempt 4 identify the unknown subject.
