ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963 DALLAS, TEXAS

On April 5, 1978, a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, assigned to the Los Angeles Division, obtained one package containing a 16 millimeter motion picture film from Captain American Airlines, 576 Flight Number 77, arriving at Gate 47, Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). This film was immediately thereafter transferred to the Los Angeles Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for appropriate handling.

On April 6, 1978, the aforementioned 16 millimeter motion picture film was taken by a Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation of the Los Angeles Office to Powell Hall, Second Floor, University of Southern California, for reviewing as requested by a member of the House Select Committee on Assassinations, U.S. House of Representatives.

A Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation maintained physical custody and physical observation of this film throughout its viewing and immediately thereafter returned this film to the Los Angeles Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
