ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY
NOVEMBER 22, 1963

On August 5, 1978, at 2:00 p.m., a woman who identified herself as [redacted] Canada, telephoned FBI Headquarters and advised that a man by the name of [redacted] has been bragging about shooting President John F. Kennedy. [redacted] was described as being six feet tall with gray hair. He allegedly drives a blue Ford truck with [redacted] License [redacted]

During the conversation the caller appeared disoriented at times and at other times was totally incoherent. She wept heavily and could not understand why the FBI could not "come and get this man." She also appeared to be extremely afraid of [redacted] She was told to contact local authorities if she was fearful; however, she did not seem to comprehend any of the suggestions made to her. The conversation lasted approximately ten minutes. Several minutes of this consisted of uncontrolled sobbing by the caller.
