GRANT STATED THAT THE GUN USED BY RUBY TO KILL LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS PART OF RUBY'S ESTATE AND REMAINED IN THE POSSESSION OF ATTORNEY MAYER.

BE RETURNED TO MAYER, BUT FURNISHED TO THE ARCHIVES FOR

PERMANENT CUSTODY.

GRANT STATED ANOTHER BROTHER, SAM RUBY, 16250 BIRCHER,
GRANADA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, HAS DISCUSSED THIS MATTER WITH
HER AND IS IN AGREEMENT. GRANT SAID SHE HAD SENT A
TELEGRAM TO CONGRESSMAN STOKES, CHAIRMAN, CAPTIONED
COMMITTEE, SETTING FORTH THE ABOVE.
