ON AUGUST 21, 1978, A FEMALE IDENTIFYING HERSELF AS  
EVA GRANT, SISTER OF JACK RUBY, 7356 BEVERLY BOULEVARD,  
LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, TELEPHONE 935-2297 (LOS ANGELES),  
ADVISED AS FOLLOWS:

AT THE TIME OF THE DEATH OF JACK RUBY, GRANT WAS THE  
ADMINISTRATOR OF HIS ESTATE BY VIRTUE OF A WILL. GRANT  
SAID A DALLAS ATTORNEY, JULES MAYER, PRODUCED A SUBSEQUENT  
WILL BY RUBY WHICH WAS DECLARED BINDING BY A COURT IN  
DALLAS. GRANT STATED THAT THE GUN USED BY RUBY TO KILL  
LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS PART OF RUBY'S ESTATE AND REMAINED  
IN THE POSSESSION OF ATTORNEY MAYER.

GRANT STATED HER PURPOSE IN CALLING FBI WAS TO RESTATE HER POSITION THAT JACK RUBY'S GUN SHOULD BE FURNISHED TO THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES AND NOT MADE AVAILABLE FOR SALE OR COMMERCIAL EXPLOTATION. GRANT SAID SHE HAD BEEN OFFERED \$70,000 FOR THE WEAPON IF SHE COULD OBTAIN POSSESSION OF IT, BUT SHE PREFERS IT TO BE IN THE POSSESSION OF THE ARCHIVES. GRANT SAID RECENT MEDIA COVERAGE INDICATED THIS GUN WAS CURRENTLY IN DALLAS FOR TEST FIRING AND SHE DESIRED THE GUN NOT BE RETURNED TO MAYER, BUT FURNISHED TO THE ARCHIVES FOR PERMANENT CUSTODY.

GRANT STATED ANOTHER BROTHER, SAM RUBY, 16250 BIRCHER, GRANADA HILLS, CALIFORNIA, HAS DISCUSSED THIS MATTER WITH HER AND IS IN AGREEMENT. GRANT SAID SHE HAD SENT A TELEGRAM TO CONGRESSMAN STOKES, CHAIRMAN, CAPTIONED COMMITTEE, SETTING FORTH THE ABOVE.
