ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KERNEDY, NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS

contacted the Lakeland, Florida, Resident Agency and advised that she had information concerning the John F. Kennedy assassination. She stated that this information concerned an individual that she did not want to Hentify over the telephone and that she wanted a Federal Bureau of Investigation agent to visit her residence so that she could talk to him personally.

two separate occasions by that he had interviewed her in his effice along with his investigator,

He stated that he seemed to him to be very implantible.
He stated that he and his investigator were both skeptical of the story and had advised her to contact the Federal Bureau of Investigation since meither one of them could do anything with the information.
