~~DAVID~~ DAVID FERRIE telephonically advised the writer on 11/28/63

that he had supplied some erroneous information to SA WALL which he would like to correct. He stated that he had been reminded by ED VOEBEL, who can be contacted through Quality Florists, Canal St., New Orleans that LEE OSWALD had been a member of the Moisant Squadron of the Civil Air Patrol in 1955. He stated that at that time he (FERRIE) was not active in the Civil Air Patrol at that time but that he had agreed to assist this squadron for a brief time.

FERRIE stated that VOEBEL told him that a recruit graduating class had been over to his (FERRIE'S) house and that LEE OSWALD may have been with this group.
