**Ferrie Files Suit
Search for Will**

An attorney for the family of David W. Ferrie, Kennedy death probe figure who died after the investigation opened, today went into Civil District Court with a petition to search for a will.

Attorney John P. Nelson Jr. represented Ferrie's family, J. T. Ferrie Jr. in filing the petition. Ferrie was found dead in his apartment at 2630 Louisiana Ave. on Feb. 24, about a week after news reports of the probe first appeared.

Orleans Parish Coroner Nicholas J. Chenu, following an autopsy, reported Ferrie died of natural causes.
