## Tape Alleges NBC Talk Garrison. with Witness

District Attorney Jim Garrison Wednesday quoted one of his assassination probe witnesses as saving that a local newsman asked her for a taped interview and told her that Garrison was "going to be destroyed."

What was purported to be a transcript of interview with Marleno Mancuso, exwife of muterial witness Gordon Miei, was included in a press release in which Garrison again blasted the National Broadcasting Co. The Time view was suposedly conducted by Garrison and Louis Ivon, his chief investigator, May 20.
