On September 16, 1975, the jury trial in USDC, NDT, Lubbock, Texas, commenced in the case of U. S. vs NELSON BUNKER HUNT and W. HERBERT HUNT. On September 26, 1975, NELSON BUNKER HUNT and W. HERBERT HUNT were found not guilty on all six counts of the indictment by the jury in USDC, NDT, Lubbock, Texas.

On September 24, 1975, the United States Attorney's Office, Dallas, Texas, advised that on September 22, 1975, HALDERT O. WOODWARD, U. S. District Judge, NDT, signed an order in the case of U. S. vs NELSON EUNKER HUNT, W. HERBERT HUNT, RALPH SHANK, CHARLES TESSMER, B. H. TIMMINS, JR., EDWARD J. HUDSON, and PERCY FOREMAN, criminal #3-75-281, which set forth:
