He also indicated he married a Russian girl born in Leningrad and wanted to bring her to the U.S. with him. On 7/10/61, OSTALD executed in "Application for Renewal of Passport" at the merican libassy in Moscow. His residence at that time was USSR, Ulitsa Kalinina 4, Apt. 24, Minsk. This renewal application indicated that OSMALD was issued U.S. Passport #1733242 on 9/10/59, at Washington, D. C. The subject's renewal application was referred to the State Department for consideration and On 7 1761, OSWALD appeared at the American Embassy in Moscow at which time he stated he was employed in the BeloRussian Radio and Television factory in Minsk as a metal worker in the research shop. He stated he took no oath or allegiance of any kind to the Soviet Union, nor was he required . sign any paper in contection with his employment He gave iii earnings as 90 rubels a month. OSWALD was married, 4/30/61, to MARIAN NIKOLAEVNA PUSAKOVA / a dental technician. OSWALD said that he intended to apply for an exit 

visa immediately upon his return to Minsk. He also stated that he desired to bring his wife with him to the U.S.

By memo dated 8/18/61, the State Department authorized the American Embassy in Moscow to renew OSWALD's passport for direct travel to the U.S.
