Reference is made to Buairtels to DL 12-11, 19 and 23-63 and 1-8-64, transmitting photographic copies of address book and other material picked up by DL Police Department under search warrant at residences of the captioned subject and his wife. You were also furnished translations of some of the material and were instructed to review the material for leads and include in the investigative reports where appropriate.

The President's Commission has expressed an extreme interest in all of the material obtained by the DL Police Department under search warrant and at the Commission's request, the Bureau is furnishing either the original material or photographs of the material to the Commission. It is imperative, therefore, that we make certain that all logical action has been taken with regard to this material. The Bureau has rephotographed all of the material in possession of the Bureau and will send a complete set of these photographs to you by separate mail. The Bureau has also made complete translations of some of the items for which summary translations only were previously made. Copies of these translations will also be sent to you. The Bureau will examine the books and literature which were not completely photographed to make certain that no pertinent material is secreted therein and that they contain no pertinent writings by subject or his wife. If any such pertinent material is found, you will be advised.

It is requested that you carefully review each of the items of personal effects to make certain that proper action has been initiated. If, during the course of your re-examination

or telephone numbers only are listed, leads were

interest to Oswald. Marina Oswald interviewed
about each name, address and telephone number
listed.

It is requested that you take the same action with regard to the material belonging to the Paines which was obtained by the DL Police Department. Since no inventory is available, the material should be divided into categories and you should indicate for the Bureau whether or not each category has been included in a report (if so specify date and page number) and summarize action taken with regard to each category.

It is emphasized that this is a double check to make certain that all logical action has been taken. Obviously because of the interest of the Commission it must be handled as soon as possible. Any question as to the scope of investigation or the desirability of setting out specific leads for any particular item should be immediately presented to the Bureau with your recommendation.
