Mrs. JESSIE JAMES GARNER, 4909 Magazine St., New Orleans, La., advised on 10/1/63 that subjects vacated their apartment on 9/25/63. Mrs. OSWALD and young child left in station wagon bearing Texas license plate driven by same woman who brought Mrs. OSWALD to New Orleans from Texas. LEE OSWALD told Mrs. GARNER that his wife is going to have a baby and that she was going to Texas for the event. She said OSWALD left owing her 17 days rent for apartment.

Mrs. CHARLES F. MURPHY, 1757 French St., New Orleans, La., LEE OSWALD's aunt, advised on 10/1/63 that when Mrs. OSWALD originally came to New Orleans a woman driving a station wagon brought her and the baby from

Will attempt to identify the Russian speaking woman who drives a station wagon and who brought Mrs. OSWALD and the child to New Orleans and on 9/25/63 came to New Orleans and brought Mrs. OSWALD and the child to Texas.

In the event the above leads are unproductive in locating the subjects, will through appropriate sources review records of births recorded inasmuch as the subject's second child is due to arrive sometime about the middle of October, 1963.
