This is classic FBI "investigation" of the leak for which, with little doubt, it was responsible. Note last graf, p.2, noting that a copy was at FBIHQ and not furnished to any field office "or anyone outside of Bureau headquarters." Of course: it was furnished inside FBIHQ. Directly or indirectly to Kilhallen.

And everyone except the FBI's official leakers was questioned.

Note that while eight copies are noted as having been made, distribution of only seven is indicated in the original. The Unrecorded copies are additional xeroxes.

So, the FBI uses all the right rhetoric and reaches the preordained conclusion, knowing all the while what it was necessary not to do and to say to make it appear that a diligent investigation was conducted when none was at all.
