Er. MOBERT G. STORBY, home address 3525 Turtle Creck Drive, Dallas, Texas, currently attending the Democratic National Convention, Atlantic City, New Jersey, advised that subsequent to the shooting and demise of LEE HARVEY OSUMAD on November 24, 1933, Texas Governor JOHN R. CONHOLLY appointed a State Court of Inquiry of which he was a member. The other participants were VAGGONER CARR the Attorney General of the State of Texas, and LEON JAVONSKI, a Houston, Texas, attorney. The purpose of the Court of Inquiry was to concuct an investigation relative to the death of LEE HARVEY OSWALD and to submit a report on the findings to the Governor.

On June 7, 1964, Mr. STORMY was one of several persons who participated in interviewing JACK L: NUBY in the County Jail, Dallas, Texas. Mr. STORMY stated he was in personal contact with Mr. NUBY for a period of approximately two hours on that date.

Lr. STOREY advised that he does not know DOROTHY KILGALLEN personally. She was in attendance at the JACK L. RUBY trial in Dallas, Texas, representing a New York newspaper, "The New York Journal American".

Lr. STORRY stated he has never not nor been in the company of DOROTHY KILGALLEN and does not know how she came into possession of testimony given by RUBY before the President's Commission.
