ADD TEXAS INQUIRY AUSTIN

IN WASHINGTON, CARR SAID HE AGREED TO A SUGGESTION BY WARREN THAT THE TEXAS COURT OF INQUIRY BE POSTPONED FOR THE TIME BEING.

IN HIS LETTER TO CARR, WARREN SAID THAT HIS OWN COMMISSION "WOULD NOT WANT TO INTERFERE." BUT HE ALSO ADDED: "IT IS THE VIEW OF THE COMMISSION THAT A PUBLIC INQUIRY IN THE STATE OF TEXAS AT THIS TIME WOULD BE MORE HARMFUL THAN HELPFUL IN THE MUTUAL SEARCH FOR THE TRUTH."

CARR SAID HE AND LEON JAWORSKI, A HOUSTON LAWYER WHO HAD BEEN APPOINTED TO HEAD THE TEXAS BOARD, HAVE BEEN IN WASHINGTON FOR THE PAST THREE DAYS. HE SAID THEY HAD CONFERRED WITH DEPUTY ATTY. GEN. NICHOLAS KATZENBACH, FBI DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER AND CHIEF JUSTICE WARREN CONCERNING THE INVESTIGATION OF KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION.

HE SAID HE HAD RECEIVED THE LETTER FROM WARREN TODAY.
