The attached states that information has been received that one [REDACTED] who claims to be a correspondent of radio America and the British Broadcasting Company in New York City, allegedly has a tape of an interview between James Earl Ray and an unknown individual regarding the details of a pay-off of the assassination. The interview is alleged to have taken place three months before the assassination. (Assassination April 4, 1968) U

We do not have any information that such a tape exists. U

In view of the manner in which this information has been received, we are instructing our New York Office to determine if [REDACTED] does exist, his affiliations, and to closely follow this matter. U [CONFIDENTIAL]
