SUBJECT: REVIEW OF TESTIMONY WARREN COMMISSION

> Remymemo of 1/21/65 setting forth certain observations noted in my review of Vol 1 of the hearings.

In the testimony of ROBERT EDWARD LEE OSWALD on 2/21/64 (see pages 410-412 of this testimony) the witness described an interview with MARINA OSWALD at the Inn of the Six Flags, Arlington, Texas, by two FBI agents, Mr. Brown and an unidentified agent. The witness said the agent, "not Mr. Brown", was harsh in his manner of interviewing Marina. He said "they" were implying that if MARINA did not cooperate with the FBI "they" would deport her back to Russia. LEON GOPADZE of the USSS was interpreting and it appears SA MIKE HOWARD, USSS, and ROBERT EDWARD LEE OSWALD were present during this interview.

It is recommended this testimony be pointed out to Bureau in the event it would be desired to secure affadavits from SAs C.T. BROWN and JAMES P. HOSTY in this regard. SA HOSTY was the other interviewing agent.
