As more and more revelations about the Watergate affair are made public, another far more serious and damaging scandal is coming to light. It is now clear that in January, 1969, with the help of secret financing and by using deception, slander, and intrigue, a group of unprincipled men with authoritarian right-wing leanings—among them Richard Nixon, H. R. Haldeman, John Ehrlichman, John Dean, and Ronald Ziegler—broke into the White House with the intent of destroying the Constitution of the United States, eliminating half a century of social progress and re-making America in their own vicious, petty image, and that now, more than four years later, they're still there. □
