Ian McDonald agrees this has to have drawn on ordinarily inaccessible CIA sources. I can use some help that may interest you and I think will expand your understanding of how such things can work. I do not have, have not read and now don't have time to read his Bay Pigs book. I assume your library has it. I would appreciate xeroxes of the index pages where Eduardo, Hunt, Barker, Bernie and Bender would be. There will probably be many Bender listings. (If you have time to see if any seem to point to or describe Hunt would be good to know.) I suspect there will be no Eduardo Also Droller. If there is indication of a second-in-command to Bender, superior to Barker/Bernie, I'd like to know that also. Hunt, considering himself crossed by CIA, is crossing it and is getting the treatment, of which Szulc is part. Somewhat related is the story you sent on Hunt's book. It confirms my belief that his publisher leaked to UPI but otherwise does not add to what was published. This was good to know.
