In sorry this imposition of a policy deternination on what is or can be news continues．You do not thikik in those terms，I＇m sure，but this is what we found so wrong under Hitler and Stalin，dirferent 2 it is in degree．

I＇m sorry，too，the＇s the fost doos not take its obligations more seriously． In the future some of you may come to regret this and in the present you alienate many who are turned off by this policy．
