Supreme Court refused today to order the FBI to remove the Secrety lakel on its files on the John F. Kennedy assassination. The Court declined to review a loner court ruling which held that the FBI has broad powers to deternine what it can suppress under the Freedom of Information Act.

THE LEGAL ACTION WAS BROUGHT BY HAROLD WEISBERGS AUTHOR OF FOUR BOOKS ON THE ASSASSINATION. THE FRI REFUSED THE REQUEST ON GROUNDS THE EVIDENCE WAS PART OF "INVESTIGATORY FILES COMPILED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES" AND THUS EXEMPT FROM THE FREEDOM OF INFORMA-TION ACT.
