In the final hours of cite checking Chapter 6, Mr. Liebeler and Mr. Griffin pointed out that there was absolutely no citation of authority to the discussion regarding the secret agent "D". They felt this to be a marked deficiency. Though not feeling as strongly as did they, I tended to agree with them that it would be useful in stating the discussion regarding "D". Therefore, we cited to an Exhibit No. and it was left for me to provide the exhibit which would back up the citation.

Therefore, I have taken from our files the CIA material on "D" and have prepared it in a manner which I think should be exemptible to you and Mr. Slawson and the CIA as well. All references to "D" and other information which might serve to identify him have been deleted. More could be deleted if you or others think it necessary. It should be concluded that even the excise documents should not be printed, we could easily prepare a file memorandum that would state something to the effect that we received information regarding "D" from the CIA but for security reasons the material cannot be published.
