Grapevine, Texas, was interviewed concerning information by JACK at BFOXIE relative to a cabin owned by JACK RUBY at UFAULVINE Lake and also concerning information furnished by PRENTISS 1. VAUGHN concerning the drilling of a water well on property of Log Cabin Enterprises. He related the following:

About four or five years ago, JACK RUBY, in association with TED NEWBERRY and MORTON GIMPLE, built two log cabin near YATES's house at Grapevine Lake. The cabins were built resale, but apparently they were too high-priced and they were the only ones built. During the building of the first cabin JACK RUBY would occasionally come out to Grapevine Lake to help with the construction. An airline pilot later drilled a well with the construction.
