

# Group Aims Campus War On Leftists

Young Americans for Freedom, a conservatively oriented student group announced a campaign yesterday to quell new left disorders on college campuses.

Organization officials at a press conference here said they will rely heavily on law suits and injunctions, but may also resort to limited physical confrontations in certain cases.

Young Americans for Freedom plans to bring the new left to court for violations of students' civil rights and to take campus administrators to court for failing to keep classes in session and buildings open, said Ronald F. Docksai, its national secretary.

A national staff member, Allan Brownfeld, said college administrators have neglected their responsibilities to keep campuses open. "We want to put pressure on . . . to keep the administrations honest."

Docksai said the organization has 450 chapters with 50,000 members on campuses throughout the nation.
