
Dear Mr. Yslas:

As the researcher on the ROBERT F. KENNEDY AND HIS TIMES
Miniseries for CBS for over a year and a half I have come to
have great respect for history and archival investigation. Just
as Arthur Schlesinger made a major contribution to American
history documentation in writing Robert Kennedy and His Times,
from which we adapted the miniseries, I think it is just as im-
portant that the Robert F. Kennedy Assassination Archives have
access to the Los Angeles Police Department's files on Senator
Kennedy's assassination, so that the American public can learn
from this tragedy and so we can prevent this kind of thing from
happening ever again.

the American people, this information must be made public.
