Your topic is an interesting one, perhaps one of the more interesting. May I suggest that as part of it you considered whether or not it would have been possible to bring him to trial, whether an impartial jury could have been selected, whether the alleged evidence could have been used in court.

I do not have time to make detailed suggestions. You say you have read my "book". I have published four. I assume you refer to WHITEWASH. The chapter "Oswald's Legal Rights" in it should be helpful to you. I think you will find the kind of material you need in all the books. The fourth has an appendix of about 150 peges of once-suppressed evidence. You have my permission to make and use photocopies of any of that you might want to use as evidence (for example, the Carolyn Arnold reports, or those on Willis, etc.). In Whitewash II I think the material in the Secret Service sections, especially what shows they ac ount for the assassination in a way that proves there could not have been but a single assassing (and the FBI did the same. You can use these documents). The pictures in WHITEWASH II you should be able to use effectively.

OSWALE IN NEW ORLEANS is a different kind of book. I think, in it, those FBI reports indicating an immediate investigation of thexpressures ant-Cestro Cuben angles that can be regarded only as frivelous is something you could make effectiven use of.

Please excuse the heate. I enclose a list of the books so you will know what you may want.

When you have finished, I'd eppreciate a copy of your paper. Parhaps you will see what I haven't.
