

As director of Cuban counterintelligence units monitoring the activities of anti-Castro Cuban exiles in 1963, Escalante is Cuba's most authoritative expert on the Kennedy assassination. From 1976 to 1982, he was head of the Cuban State Security Department (known as G2). He conducted

ations and operations designed to break up CIA plans to subvert Cuba and assassinate Fidel Castro, plans later admitted by the CIA in various U.S. government commissions. In 1978 he directed a special Cuban investigation in response to a request for assistance from the U.S. congressional committee examining the Kennedy assassination.

Our endeavors concerning this case have been mainly directed at making it clear to U.S. and world public opinion that we [Cuba] had nothing to do with this horrible crime.
