Kennedy slay link held here

ILIGAN CITY, Dec. 10 —(PNS) — A Yemenite from California under surveillance for some-time on suspicion of possible complicity in the as-sassination of "VIPs" in the US, was arrested here Sunday noon.

It took five law enforcers to subdue All All Sauidi, about 35, of Mo-desto, California. He had run into a local hospital, hid in an X-ray room, and put up a fight. Arresting officers, ap-

parently bound by sec-

recy, would not give de-tails about the Yemenite.

Saridi, who showed an identification card purportedly issued by the Stevedores Union of Ca-lifornia, was taken to Marawi City for interrogation by government intelligence men.

The Yemenite could not produce papers to show that he had entered the country legally, it was learned.
