MINUTES OF THE STAFF MEETING, APRIL 24, 1964

PRESENT - Mr. Rankin, Mr. Hubert, Mr. Willens, Mr. Slawson, Prof. Redlich, Mr. Liebeler, Mr. Stern, Mr. Ball, Mr. Ely, Mr. Mosk, Miss Scobey, Mr. Eisenberg, Dr. Goldberg, Mr. Jenner.

Mr. Rankin introduced Miss Scobey who will be aiding Senator Russell.

Mr. Rankin discussed the printing aspects of the report. There is talk of printing up the appendix now. Apparently they cannot get it to us by June 1, but hopefully, shortly thereafter.

Two people will be here from the Printing Office to help us organize the material.

A discussion concerning the organization of the hearings, depositions and exhibits followed. It was decided to try to get the depositions and hearings "edited" so that the witness could read and sign the transcripts of their testimony. The handling of exhibits was discussed. Anybody who collects an exhibit, should give them to Mr. Eisenberg who will handle the physical arrangements of getting them reproduced. The FBI will reproduce everything unless told otherwise by the attorney.

Mr. Eisenberg will deal with the printer and Mr. Rankin, Prof. Redlich and Mr. Willens will handle revision. Mr. Eisenberg will group the depositions.
