

## COMMISSION FILES PRINTED AS EXHIBITS

In the archive is a 32-page, handwritten listing of those Commission files parts or all of which were printed by the Commission as exhibits in its 26 volumes. It is headed, "Prepared by Mrs. Riley, National Archives, May 1965." The very last thing the Commission printed (26H862) is its Exhibit No. 3154, entitled "Commission Numbers Assigned to Previous Commission Documents". The Commission called its files "documents". In the case of those printed, it is not the entire file, but part of it that is referred to in the printed tabulation. Some of the files are quite large.

So, parts of the same files can be different exhibits. In some cases, the same papers were entered into evidence with different exhibit numbers. Thus, parts of the fourth file ~~xxxx~~ are found in 82 different exhibits.

For greater clarity, this list has been typed by Mrs. Shirley Orr, of Cuba, Missouri. The first number is that of the file. Those following of the exhibits:
