Memorandum describing activities of Shirley Randall, Aide, Parkland Memorial Hospital, on November 22, 1963:

"I asked some man - I don't know who he was - if there was any more hurt before a policeman and I took the carriage in that I had; he said that he didn't think so. He asked me if I would get someone to come and wash the blood out of the car. I said that I would, but was so excited and nervous I forgot about the car."

Memorandum describing activities of Joe Richards, Orderly, Parkland Hospital, November 22, 1963:

"I went out to see if there were others injured; there weren't any. A few carriages were out at the front entrance, and I pushed one back to Minor Medicine. Then someone asked me to get a ~~bucket~~ bucket of water; I did."
