

Mr. BILL BRANNIGAN of the Bureau telephonically advised that they had been requested by Secret Service to inquire as to whether the FBI in Dallas possibly had the Governor's suit coat, which he was wearing at the time he was shot. It was described as a black silk and wool suit coat. It has his glasses, cigarette lighter, and a bunch of personal papers in it.

I assured Mr. BRANNIGAN that I had no knowledge of who has this coat; however, I would check. He asked to be called back.

I checked with SA CLEMENTS and SA BORTON, and we have no record of having ever received this coat. Mr. BRANNIGAN was so advised.
