David Belin; Roger Craig's Diary; Kary Ferrell, Penn Jones et al; Rill Boxley; Early JPK, Miprit Killings secounts.

Just as I was going to bed last might I received a phone call from Mrs. Rita Musgrove, 320 Walnut, New London, Iowa, 53645. 319/367-5952; eff 375-3195.

The immediate purpose of her call was an invitation from Penn Jones to go to Palias on the 17th for a showing it vy Gwoden of the films he usually shows plus Rush to Judgement. Secause Rita was finished with the whole Dallas gang except Craig and had sold them so pointedly, especially Fenn, she was surprised and is not going. Penn persisted, which worried her more because of violence and violent talk from him in the past. On one occasion when she was staying with the Graigs (divorced two years ago), when Roger provided bodyguards all the way to the airport (She had been beaten up at the airport once, losing teeth, etc. she says.)

She quotes Penn as saying Roger suicide four months ago (all this from memory-

taped when I saw what she was going into).

Roger kept a diary. She has it, Fenn wants it, and Roger wanted him not to have it and regarded it as cause for his own killing. She read parts to me, the reason being the way I come accross in my writing. She is an our mailing list.

I told her how to check out with Faul Rothermel whether or not moger is dead.

She has duplicated the diary out of her possession.

Her details of this whole edd bunch are consistent with what I know except for the Violence and for Penn's insistences.

This can't be complete, from memory, and because I have to go to BC.
Bexley is selling tapes of his personal conversations with warrison. e sold one dealing with im Rose to Fary for \$16. he appears to have taped all these kinds of conversations. I know he has some because I have a copy of another with Kancy Perrin. (This part of the story also in the diary. Craig astile Perrin's criminal record. It was for Penn but appears to be what Boxley told me he had obtained in Colorado.)

Roger also stole police radio tapes-three channels. 18" recls.

Hany details about police, sheriff inside, irrelevant Ruby details after hailing, Decker and what 'raig says happened to him and how, with names and dates.

Craig appears to have started keeping this diary for his son the day before JFK was due to arrive simply because it was so unusual to see a President.

Her reading of some of the early passges is entirely consistent with his testimony: except for what was omitted and what he did not add when he "corrected" it as printed at Maggie Field's.

What struck me as most important were new details of the findal/of the shells and rifle and the time those at the TSED learned about the Tippit killing. Roger looked at his which, it was 1:06. This is entirely consistent with the Bowley affidavit, ignored by the Commission/Belin in person and particular.

Different Buddy Walthers story than I get from Hudkins; inference he was killed by partner rather than man he was sent to pick up. Repeats what logs show, first Tippit shell (he says all) automatics. Rifle shells all liged up as found, suspicious to him

Fenn had told me of efforts to kill Roger. I don't recall details. Diary has two different ones, one in which man with whom he had appointment that was eatched was killed while standing next to him.

I told her my areas doubts moger and about when they begin. His diary shows first contact from Garrison via Penn, etc. He wound up hating them all.

Total about 90 pages.

Marguerite Oswald her friend, claims to have 16 more letters from LHO, Minsk. "Old man" W.C. Thompson dead. Penn bought his library.

Several visits from N.O. attorney Parkerson beginning August 1966, I think to Craige Craig's account station wagon he saw has M La. license, not Ruth Paine's.

Arrested woman brown station wagon knoll park lot. Rita has picture of woman running down tracks, not dated. Also Roger puts names back tramp pix. She is to xerox both sides

hrs. Craig remarried. Knows how to reach his mether. It deed does not know who his his records, tapes, etc.

Rits going to Dallas again soon, to see Marguerite, who wants \$40,000 for letters. Account how Lummie Lewis took those picked up to sheriff's effice. Includes

how Rowlands spotted, this station-wagon woman and other deputies named.

Bill Decker told all his men to be an hand, visibly and looking sharp but not to have any part in Presidential pretection.

Many Decker stories, all casting suspicion on kind man be was, connections, etc. Revill (unsuccessful) \*epublican eppenent of his successor, Jones.

Dent throat rifle shell noted immediately and suspected, as was alignment. Details Graig's account stationwagen picking "Oswald" up, comparisons between 12:45 pictures shown by Sprague and arrests pictures, comparisons with Tippit killer description clothing and what this driver was wearing. Inference same man who drove

Quotes Marion Daker as say it was 12:35 when he saw LED.

I asked her is references to Sweett, who handled swidence. She said yes but r ead none.

Observations attributed to Rewlands esactly as they testified.

There may well be other details I can't remember. Tires when she called. Conmection poor. She called back without much improvement. Don't know how clear tape is.

The character of these strange Dalias people is consistent with what I know, except that she dislikes then more and has more specifies from an entirely different kind of relationship. She has suspicions about Buck. Mad been told by Penn that both Ferralla Minutemen. She is tougher on Mary than I would be.

She has also has ner own notes. These include visits from Borley as late as 1971 or 1972.

Mentioned Baskston several times. Forget context.

After she broke from Penn he phoned her at Graigs and said he was coming over, insisting that she meet him outside. She refused, he said he was coming and hung up. This is when Roger called and got bodyguards, one who stayed outside and one in house, who took her to hove Field next day. This is not time she was beaten up there. While this seems farout there was nothing in the way she spoke or what she said to cast any doubt on her rationality. And despite the doubts I developed about Craig, of which I told her, there were many points of confirmation.

In her account hary controls them all. She says Kimbrough dying of cancer. It does seem strange that Penn would insist, politely, on her/comis to see Groden films when she repulsed and insulted him. But much about Penn seems strange. Graig grew to dislike and distrust him and others.

Craigh thought imbroung CIA agent. Mary servile to imbrough (money reason?) Slight references to Chapman, Sue Fitch. Some mob references, connection threat vs Craig and how officials delayed serving papers until people able to pay. Inferences

or allegations about who knew Ruby and Decker's strong opposition to anyone talking to Eva. Wichita Falls sheriff refused to accept "uby because he looked so sick. The dector who saw Muby and said he had sold was a shrink. Sold story what "erts told me. Rest not consistent dertz' story.

Pixture thoroughly authoritarian sheriff and sheriff's dept with Walthers getting away with everything short of murder, including having and bribing with pills, baving stoes property, etc and getting away with all. Including drunkenness, effensive behavior.

Buddy said to have been killed Sinference by partner) when he was expected to be called to h.O. It was before Shaw trial. I in Ballas day it shopened, got wads account. I see no reason to fear his going to H.O. unless Delianites did not know Garrison. Buddy refused to talk about "45" picture or man in it with him. Or finding "45." Why unclear. At that time I had N.O, radio reporter talk to him by phone and Walthers was responsive.

Rita seems of very good intelligence and gave no indication of interest in aut raff. She appears to have eventually seems through the Dallasites although she began friendly with "ary and lived and worked with her for several days.
