

STAFF MEETING - 4:00 P.M., MARCH 2, 1964

Mr. Willens announced that Mr. Barson, an IRS agent working on various matters in connection with the investigation, will be located in Dr. Goldberg's office.

The staff then returned to the discussion concerning the interviewing of witnesses. The major question that developed was whether inconsistencies should appear in the record. No decision resulted.

This led into a discussion of whether interviews between staff members and prospective witnesses should be recorded. Another point discussed was the final form of the report. The problem was how to deal with all of the documentary evidence.

It was decided to form a committee composed of Professor Redlich (Chairman), Mr. Belin and Mr. Liebeler to draft proposed procedures to be followed by the staff in interviewing witnesses.

At ¹⁵8:30 P.M. the meeting was recessed with the hope that the committee would iron out all the above mentioned problems.
