Manuscript Oswald Wrote To Be Published This Year

DALLAS (UPI) — A 200-page manuscript containing Lee Harvey Oswald's opinions on philosophy and his dis-enchantment with his life in Russia will be published later

this year, an attorney says.
Attorney Patrick S. Russell Jr. said the manuscript, written by Oswald in the late '50s and early '60s but kept secret until three or four days ago, describes Oswald's disenchantment with Russian life.

Russell said the manuscript will be published by the family of the late George Demohrenschildt.

Demohrenschildt died of a self-inflicted shotgun wound March 29, 1977, in Florida while he was being sought by the House Assassinations Committee for testimony about his alleged prior knowledge of the John F. Kennedy assassination.

Russell said Oswald gave Demohrenschildt the manuscript to edit.
