MEMBERS OF the Rev. Martin Luther King's family have remained close since his assassination but have chosen differing career routes.

His widow, **Coretta Scott King**, wrote a book about her life with him and has dedicated her life to perpetuating his memory — mainly through her service as chief executive officer of the King Center, a historical and cultural center in Atlanta.

Their son, **Dexter**, 35, the most outspoken of their four

children, is president of the King Center. He also is a music promoter.

His older sister, **Yolanda**, 41, is an actress who lives in New York and appeared recently in "Ghosts of Mississippi" (see her photo above).

Their brother **Martin**, 39, is a consultant in Atlanta, where he lost an election for county commissioner two years ago.

Bernice, 33, has a divinity degree and is a lecturer.
