Directing your attention to the FBI and SS documents located by the San Francisco group ~~and~~ Brown, Alberto Fowler told me he had heard from Brown, who approached him through a friend who is known to be anti-CIA.

Brown is writing a book on some aspect of the assassination. He is a publisher, of a business that would seem to be a guaranteed financial failure if it is as represented to me, specializing in guerilla warfare.

His address is Panther Publications, Box 369, Boulder, Colo. I would appreciate it if you could have Tom send Alberto a copy of the appropriate documents. He is aware of our interest and will be alert to them for he is expecting to hear further from Brown.

Alberto also told me Butler was in New Orleans about the end of February.

I think Alberto told me Patrick is writing a book.

He did tell me Dick Billings is expecting to spend three or four months here. Almost immediately I bumped into Billings in your anti-room. His face seemed so different I didn't recognize him. Possibly he was embarrassed. When I said I'd heard he planned to be here three or four months and was looking for a house he got a little flustered and said it was to be only two and he really wanted only an apartment. He also wanted to know how I knew. I told him.
